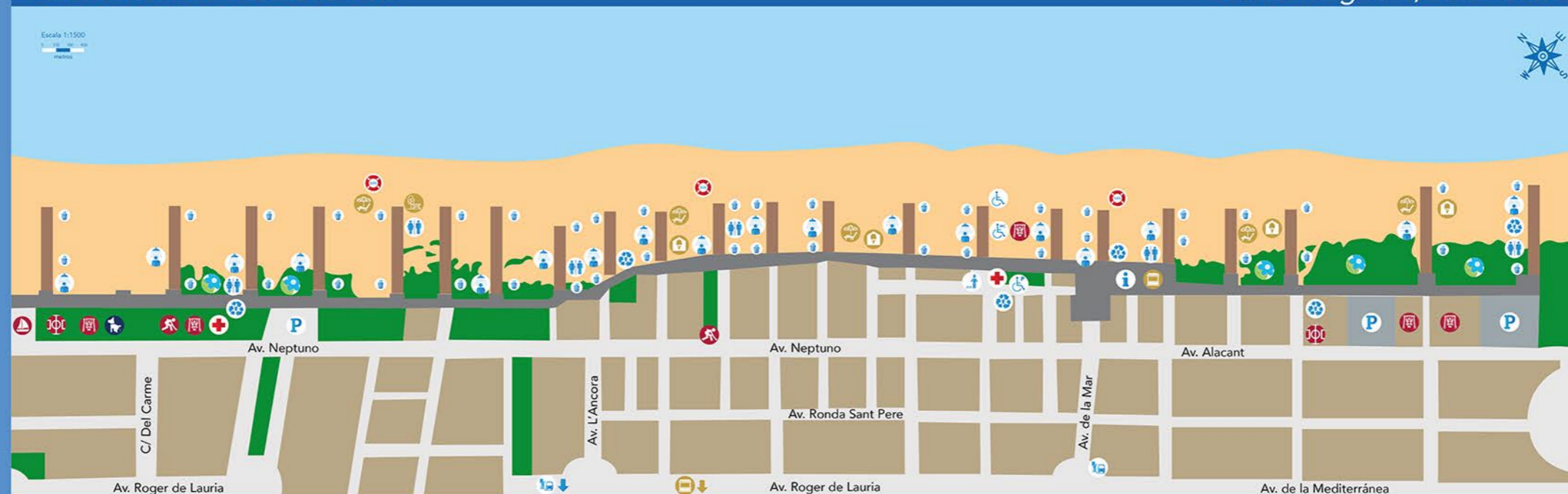

## NEARBY PROTECTED NATURAL AREAS

### THE DUNES ARE PROTECTED

The Safor Dunes, located on Daimús Beach, are part of the Natura 2000 Network, and are listed as a Special Conservation Area. This area hosts a variety of habitats associated with coastal dunes, such as fine dunes with *Crucianellion maritima*, embryonic dunes with *Malcomietalia* grass, mobile dunes with *Ammophila* and dunes with *Cisto-Lavanduletea* vegetation. In terms of protected species, the dunes are a vital area for the conservation of the Kentish plover (*Charadrius alexandrinus*), which is listed as a vulnerable species in the Valencian Catalogue of Threatened Fauna Species.



### THEY ARE IMPORTANT FOR PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION

- The dunes form on the beach and **prevent the sand from moving inland**, helping to **stop storm erosion**, which is becoming more frequent and intense due to climate change. Further offshore, the dunes serve to intercept waves, preventing them from breaking near the shoreline and thereby reducing their intensity.
- These dunes are the **beaches' sand reserves**, which are of particular importance due to the rising sea levels caused by global warming.
- They are **home to a large number of animal, plant and invertebrate species**, many of which are unique to these ecosystems, and have adapted to living under the difficult coastal conditions.
- Dune systems are **very vulnerable** to human disturbance and their plants are particularly sensitive to trampling.

### HELP US PRESERVE THEM!

Their conservation is **VITAL** to mitigate the effects of **CLIMATE CHANGE**.

- Do not trample on them.** Use the **authorised pathways** and do not allow your pets to access them.
- Value and **protect the species** that inhabit this ecosystem. Remember that vegetation is essential for the maintenance of the dune system.
- Dispose of **your rubbish in the designated bins** and containers.
- Respect and enjoy the environment **without crossing protection barriers**.

## BLUE FLAG

The **Blue Flag** is an international environmental award given to sustainable beaches, marinas and tourist boats for their **sustainable and environmentally friendly operation**.

The Blue Flag was created by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE), which also runs other programmes, such as Green Key for sustainable tourist accommodation, Eco-schools and Young Reporters for the Environment.

The presence of a Blue Flag guarantees compliance with certain legal, **accessibility, cleanliness, service and safety standards**, as well as adequate environmental **information and management**.

The **Blue Flag is awarded every year** and is valid for the **duration of the bathing season**. It is assessed by an inspection team that verifies compliance with the required criteria. **If these requirements are no longer met**, the local council is responsible for **removing the Blue Flag**, either temporarily or permanently, and informing visitors of the reason for this.

## BANDERA AZUL

La **Bandera Azul** es un galardón ambiental internacional concedido a aquellas playas, puertos deportivos y embarcaciones turísticas sostenibles, por su **gestión sostenible y respetuosa con el medio ambiente**.

La Bandera Azul ha sido creada por la Fundación para la Educación Ambiental (FEE) y desarrolla otros programas, como Llave Verde para alojamientos turísticos sostenibles, Ecoescuelas y Jóvenes Reporteros para el Medio Ambiente.

La presencia de una Bandera Azul garantiza el cumplimiento de ciertos criterios de legalidad, **accesibilidad, limpieza, servicios y seguridad**, así como una adecuada **información y gestión ambiental**.

La **concesión de la Bandera Azul se realiza cada año** y es vigente **durante esa temporada de baño**, siendo validada por un equipo de inspección que verifica el cumplimiento de los criterios exigidos. **Si éstos dejan de cumplirse**, el ayuntamiento se compromete a **arriar la Bandera Azul**, de forma temporal o definitiva, e informar a los usuarios del motivo.
